Ranger Paving completed the road repair and repaving on Friday, April 7th. There are several clean up items that will be done over the next 10 days, to include road stripes and reflectors installation.

All of us can now return to using our sprinklers on a regular basis and landscapers, pest control, tree trimmers and service trucks are again welcome to resume their normal schedules. Trash, recycling and lawn debris collection will begin on the regular Tuesday and Friday pick-up days. ***Again, please remind your landscapers that when they put their trailer gates down, they should use a guard in order to protect the newly laid asphalt as it will not set for several weeks.***
