Dear Neighbor,

As you may have already heard, several vehicles have been broken into recently on Bonaventure Dr. and Sand Wedge Dr. in our community. Unfortunately the break-ins that happened on Boneventure Dr. went unreported. These vehicles were found to be unlocked and accessed. About a week later, additional break-ins occurred; however, two vehicles reported property damage as windows were shattered. Additional break-ins have been reported in surrounding communities as well.

Please remain vigilant and report any suspicious activities to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office.

PLEASE TAKE ACTION TO HELP PREVENT FUTURE VEHICLE BREAK-INS

1. **DO** keep your vehicle garaged when not in use. If this is not an option, keep your vehicle in a well-lit area on your driveway. Leave porch and garage lights on overnight. Consider installing additional lighting for your home, if necessary. Please do not forget to submit an ARB Form for approval if you plan to add additional lighting.
2. **DO NOT** leave valuables laying out in the open. Place valuables in the trunk or another secure location.
3. **DO** use a car alarm.
4. **DO** record any and all serial numbers off your electronics. Keep the serial numbers you recorded in a secure location.
5. **DO NOT** leave your Key FOB and Garage Door Remote inside your vehicle.
6. **DO** close your garage door.
7. **DO** call the police immediately if you find or believe that you are victim. Non-Emergency: 561-688-3400.
